In alignment with this philosophy, the Interact Club remains steadfast in its commitment to social welfare. As part of this endeavour, the school recently celebrated the Joy of Giving Campaign.

Through the generous contributions of students and staff, a remarkable ₹1,96,270 was raised. A vibrant carnival was also hosted within the school premises, fostering a spirit of joy and togetherness. Several essential daily-use items were donated to various organizations, ensuring that warmth and care reached those in need.

Maika: It is a Sweet Home Anathalaya, the only organization in India that provides free boarding, lodging, education and complete care to the girls of and above the age of 18 who are orphans/homeless. Stationery, groceries, sanitary products and daily essentials were donated here. .

Arya Gurukul Tihar Gram Orphanage: It is an orphanage which is a home to forty seven young boys from 4-18 years. The orphanage looks after their education and focuses on their academics and spiritual wellbeing. We contributed five iron racks and sets of kurta-pyjamas as per their requirement..

Matra Chhaya: It is a child home for children of age group 0-6 years who take care of homeless children who are abandoned by their parents. We provided groceries to them to support their daily needs.

Akhil Bhartiya Netrahin Sangh (Blind School): It is an NGO running as a school for blind children with several facilities such as library, computer lab, etc. A water dispenser and groceries were donated to them.

Red Cross Society: It is a voluntary humanitarian organization to protect human life and health in India. It aims to inspire and initiate humanitarian activities so that human suffering could be minimized. We extended monetary support for the needy there.

Sanjay Gandhi Animal Care Centre:It is India's oldest and Delhi's largest animal shelter centre. We contributed three inspecting tables and medicines for the welfare of animals.

We have also attached the gratitude letters from these organisations who embraced our generosity with cordiality.

This campaign truly reflects the Cecilian spirit of responsibility, empathy, and helpfulness. We extend our sincere gratitude to the parents for their unflinching support in making this initiative a success.






Vocational training such as computers, music, tailoring, and handicrafts have been provided to all the members of this home.
