Eco Club of St. Cecilia's Public School, Vikaspuri, organised a special assembly for all the students of classes I to XII to mark eco- friendly Dusshera celebrations on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2024. The assembly marked a series of cultural presentations which highlighted the essence of the inevitable victory of the good over evil in this beautiful festival. The event celebrated the victory of Lord Rama over the demon king Ravana . It also celebrated the essence of Vijaydashmi in which the victory of the divine Goddess over the demon Mahishasura is mythologically celebrated.

The assembly included contemporary vocal recitals and classical dance performances in the holy name of Lord Rama and the Divine Goddess celebrating the festive spiral of Navaratre, DurgaPooja and Dusshera. Students presented a play on Ramayana in which the human inner journey of working against hatred, jealousy, ego, selfishness, revenge and greed were reflected upon.
