In compliance with D.O. letter No. 10-1/2024-EE 12 (Eco Club) dated 09.04.2025 shared by Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education, Delhi, regarding Eco Club for Mission LiFE and Circular no. DE 29(3)/UEEM/OSD/SS 2019/81-86, issued by SamagraShiksha – Delhi (A society under Education Department, Government of NCT of Delhi) dated 11.04.2025 and as instructed in the webinars mentioned in the circulars, Eco Club of St. Cecilia's Public School, Vikaspuri, initiated 'Flora QR Code Activity' on 30.04.2025 in the school campus.
