To mark the commencement of an enriching academic journey St. Cecilia's Public School organized a comprehensive Orientation Programme for the parents of Bal Vatika 1 and Prep on 25th and 27th March 2026. The session commenced with a gracious welcome by the Headmistress of the Pre-Primary Wing Ms. Bhawna Vij, who emphasized the pivotal role of parental partnership in early childhood education.
