
## St. CECILIA'S PUBLIC SCHOOL QUIZ COMPETITION SENIOR WING SESSION 2024-25













On May 20, 2024, The Quiz Club of the School organized a **Current Affairs Quiz** for students of Class XI and XII. The objective of the quiz was to enhance students' awareness of national and international events, promote healthy competition, and foster a spirit of inquisitiveness and learning. The quiz was aimed to encourage students to stay informed about current events and to develop critical thinking and quick decision-making skills besides promoting teamwork and collaborative learning among students.

In the weeks leading up to the quiz, students were encouraged to stay updated with daily news through newspapers, news apps, and school-provided resources. A Mock Quiz was also conducted for all interested students and two winners from each section participated in the onstage quiz.

The quiz consisted of several rounds, each designed to test different aspects of students' knowledge on current affairs.

Round 1: Written test with multiple-choice questions. 16 questions were asked from the participants and the answer sheets were evaluated.

Round 2: Fill Ups Round with 8 questions in all. It was a mixed bag of questions on all spheres of life like Geopolitics, Art, Sports, Films etc.

Round 3: Picture Identification Round which has 4 questions where participants have to identify the picture of a famous personality. A few hints were also given to make the identification accurate.

Round 4: Multiple Choice Questions Round had 16 Questions on different themes. The round posed a challenge for the participants as it was a negative marking round.

Round 5: X-Y Identification Round was the most challenging round for all participants as they had to fill two blanks given in a paragraph related to a current event. The round comprised of four questions, one for each team.

The event was attended by enthusiastic students of Class XI D2 and Class XII D2 who not only cheered but actively participated in the quiz by answering several questions that were open for the audience. An interactive session was held between rounds, where the audience was invited to answer some of the questions, fostering greater engagement.

The team D (Ansh Sharma and RIdhi Sharma from Class XI D2 and Vansh Gupta and Nishat from Class XII D2) emerged as the winners, demonstrating exceptional knowledge and quick thinking. The runner up was Team A (Adwaith S Panicker and Saagarika from Class XI A and Parth and Kushagra from Class XII A). Huge rounds of applause were given to both the teams.

The Participants expressed that the quiz was challenging yet enjoyable. They appreciated the diverse range of topics covered and the competitive spirit it invoked. An increase in students' interest in current events leading up to the quiz was noticed and commended the event for its educational value. The student organisers were praised for organising such an engaging and informative event, suggesting that it become a regular part of the school calendar.

The Current Affairs Quiz was a resounding success, achieving its goal of making students more aware of the world around them. The enthusiasm and participation from students, along with positive feedback from teachers and audience, highlight the event's impact and importance. Plans are already underway to make this quiz a frequent event, with more teams and innovative rounds to keep the competition exciting and informative.
