Title: Shopping Bill Activity

The Mathematics Club conducted an engaging activity in class III on “Shopping Bill ” on 28th January 2026. The objective of the activity was to help students understand the concept of money and arithmetic through a visual and hands-on approach.

The activity encouraged students to:

- Understand the concept of billing using constructive approach.
- Enhance their logical and analytical skills through Mental Maths and calculation.
- Develop financial literacy through visual representation of items and price list .

Activity Description:

Students were provided with a structured worksheet featuring various items and their prices to stimulate real world shopping experience. The exercise required students to carefully identify the items and write down individual amounts in the designated columns. To complete the task addition was performed to calculate the grand total. To further stimulate a problem solving challenge to guess which operation of mathematics needs to be used was given (₹1000 - ₹542) and they had to determine the remaining balance . The activity enabled students to accurately document transactions and calculate grand total using multi-step addition. By solving the ₹1000 challenge, they mastered subtraction and the concept of receiving change. This practical exercise successfully bridged classroom Maths with real-world financial literacy and logical budgeting. Overall, the activity was successful in making the concept clear and interactive promoting meaningful and enjoyable learning.
