A quiz-making competition was organised by the Quiz Club - Senior Wing in the month of August 2024 for the students of Class 9 and 10, centred around the theme "**Unity in Diversity in India.**" The event aimed to promote awareness and understanding of India's rich cultural heritage and diversity among students. Participants were tasked with designing creative and informative quizzes that highlighted various aspects of India's cultural, religious, and linguistic diversity while showcasing the sense of unity that binds the nation.

The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from both Classes, with over 50 students submitting quizzes. Each quiz covered different regions, languages, traditions, festivals, and customs that exemplify India's pluralistic society.
