Title: Formation of 4 digit number using number cards

The Mathematics Club conducted an engaging activity in class III on “ 13th April 2026”. The primary objective of the activity was to enable students understand the concept of place value and develop the ability to read, write and form four digit number through experimental learning.

The activity encouraged students to:

- Strengthen the understanding of place value (Thousands, Hundreds ,Tens , Ones).
- Develop accuracy in reading and writing four digit numbers.
- Enhance the logical reasoning and numerical skills.

Activity Description:

Students brought number cards (0-9) along a well designed activity sheet displaying place value columns- Thousands, Hundreds, Tens, Ones. They were instructed to arrange the numbers and construct numbers.

Through this engaging activity, students clearly understood how the position of a digit determines its value in a number. They also practiced reading aloud which was further reinforced into conceptual learning

The activity created a lively environment in learning the concept in an enjoyable manner. Overall, it was successful in building a foundation in number formation and place value..
